- 1) Royal Northumberland Yacht Club Limited is a company limited by guarantee (company number 08544867) and carries on its business under the name Royal Northumberland Yacht Club
- 2) The objects of the Royal Northumberland Yacht Club shall be to promote community participation in the sport of sailing by the provision of facilities and instruction and to encourage the building and improvement of yachts
- 3) Amateurs only are eligible
- 4) Membership Types are as follows:-

a) Ordinary Persons aged 25 or over

b) Ordinary (Reduced) Persons who have attained 18 but not yet 25 years of age (18 - 24)

Husband and Wife, or Partners living at the same address with or without c) Ordinary (Family)

children (being cadets). Single Parent with children (being cadets)

d) Cadet Persons who have attained 7 but not yet 18 years of age (7 - 17) Persons who make less than normal use of the Club's facilities e) Associate f) Student

- b) First year subscriptions are payable immediately on election
- c) Subsequent subscriptions are due in advance on 1st February
- d) An Entrance Fee of £50 is payable for all new members except Cadet members (not included in a Family membership) and temporary members.
- e) The Club is fully affiliated to the Royal Yachting Association (RYA), however Club membership does not include personal membership of the RYA
- Admission to membership does not guarantee mooring or boatyard accommodation
- Mooring instructions must be understood and strictly adhered to in order to avoid unnecessary damage to craft
